

Preamble

The IEI Industry Excellence Award has been instituted to recognize industry leaders for their innovation, excellence in engineering operations and thereby, to lead their industry in competitive manner. The bench-marks created by the industries in India have included productivity, quality, safety and performance assurance thereby giving India the rightful place in the global markets.

Realizing that such industries can provide the leadership to a large number of other industries in the country, it has been considered appropriate by the IEI Council to launch the IEI Industry Excellence Awards in the year 2008.

Modalities for the Award

The award is 'application based' and every engineering industry working in the country is welcome to participate. The application has to be sent in the enclosed format, which can also be downloaded from the website: www.ieindia.info along with the requisite application fee. The application format and the fee can also be submitted online. However, the application is to be submitted in 4 copies along with a soft copy in a CD and all the supporting documents, like the Audited Account, Annual Report, Sustainability Report etc.

An undertaking is to be furnished by the applicant that the information and documents are true to the best of their knowledge and agree to indemnify any damage that might arise due to wrong information.

Categories of Awards

The Awards would be given to the organisations engaged in engineering manufacturing and services under the following categories

Category A: those organisations having turnover of Rs.100 cr and above

Category B: those organisations having turnover of Rs.25 cr and above but below Rs. 100 cr.

Category C: those organisations having turnover below Rs.25 cr.

What do you gain by applying for the Award ?

The proforma, having self-assessment procedure, will give the applicant organisation confidence about performance of the industry in the process of applying for this award. The proforma is based on international standards and is prepared by experts to collect information on the performance of the applicant industries.

What will Jury look for?

The Jury for the selection will look for the procedure being followed by the industry and their bench marking. The Jury will also look into the innovative approaches that the industry has been involved in and the improvement in performance in the industry (the information to be duly backed up by the data for 3 years of performance). The Jury will also be interested in finding out thrust of the corporate governance and corporate social responsibility strategies and other innovative approaches, improving competitiveness to the greater benefit of the country and the society.

Assessment Process

The assessment of the applications will be carried out at two levels as follows :

1. The first level of assessment would be carried out based on the weightage given to different items in the application proforma. This Assessment Committee comprises Brig S V S Chowdhury, Chairman, BOG, Safety & Quality Forum, The Institution of Engineers (India), New Delhi as Chairman, and other Committee Members are Dr S Nagabhushana Rao, Council Member, IEI, Mr A K Saxena, Council Member, IEI and President, Bhushan Power Steel Limited, Ranchi, Mr Ashok Basa, Council Member, IEI and Director (Technical), B Engineers & Builders Ltd, Bhubaneswar. The Assessment Committee will also have independent assessors. The shortlisted applications will then be selected and presented to the Jury.
2. The Jury will be the second level and the final decision making body to be headed by Lt Gen (Dr) V J Sundaram, Former Chairman, NDRF, other Members of Jury are Prof S S Chakraborty, CMD Consulting Engineering Services, New Delhi, Mr K K Kapila, Chairman, IRF India, Mr Pradeep Chaturvedi, Vice Chairman, Energy Committee, WFEO and Padmashree Prof R M Vasagam, Chairman, BOG-NDRF.

The Jury will have independent eminent engineers drawn from different sectors including Government, PSUs and private industries.

The decision of the Jury would be communicated to the selected award winners. The decision of the Jury shall be final and binding.

Application Fee

The application fees are as under:

Category A : Rs. 30,000

Category B : Rs. 20,000

Category C : Rs.10,000

In case of necessity to verify the facts, a visit to the industry by any assessors or experts may be made and same will have to be facilitated by the applicant by arranging for the travel and local hospitality.

Payments to be made by cross demand draft/pay order drawn in favour of **THE INSTITUTION OF ENGINEERS (INDIA)**, payable at Kolkata.

Last Date

The last date for application is 25th September, 2011.

Award presentation

The Awards will be presented at the Inaugural Ceremony of the **Indian Engineering Congress** of The Institution of Engineers [India] being held during the month of December each year. This year the Indian Engineering Congress will be held at Bangalore, Karnataka during December 15-18, 2011.

The Award

The Award will be given in the form of a Gold Plated Plaque and a Certificate.
